Reservations are for two-bed/two-bath and three-bed/three bath condos each with a balcony overlooking the slope. Additional amenities include fireplace, fully equipped kitchen, barbeque, high speed Internet, washer/dryer, porterage and complimentary on-call shuttle service throughout Snowmass.
